Navy Federal Credit Union Adds Remote Key

Navy Federal Credit Union, the largest credit union in the world, has recently added the ability to remotely establish ATM initial encryption keys automatically from their corporate headquarters to any of their ATMs worldwide.

Navy Federal recently installed both the remote key option to their A98 ATM Initial Key Establishment system from Trusted Security Solutions, Inc. as well as a direct interface to their Connex ATM driving software from eFunds to permit the use of RSA cryptography for distribution of ATM terminal master keys. Navy Federal is now in the planning stages to use this new technology to roll out triple DES to all the ATMs not already at triple DES level.

“This is an important milestone for our credit union in particular because we have ATMs all over the world.” says Jeff Rath, Information Security Manager for Navy Federal. “With remote key loading, when the technician sets the ATM to triple DES, our system sends down a unique, triple DES key automatically. Using the A98-R this way basically eliminates triple DES as “a project” and makes it a procedure.”
